## Kentucky Home Performance

### Kentucky Home Performance (KHP) Incentives

KHP offers incentives of 20 percent of the total installation cost for a maximum rebate of \$2,000 per home for eligible improvements.

- or -

A low-interest rate loan at 6.99 percent is also available for eligible improvements.

### Other Incentives

State and federal tax credits may apply.

Some additional local utility and manufacturer rebates may be available in your area.

Kentucky Home Performance incentives may be put toward a wide range of energy-saving projects, including any work (labor costs) dedicated to achieving the Minimum Requirements, plus:

- **Additional Insulation and Air-Sealing Work**
- **ENERGY STAR® Windows and Doors**
- **ENERGY STAR® Air-Source Heat Pumps\***  
AHRI certificate included  
\* If not labeled Energy Star®, minimum SEER ≥14.5 and HSPF ≥8.2 for **split** systems and minimum SEER≥14 and HSPF≥8.0 for single **package** equipment including gas/electric package units.
- **ENERGY STAR® Central A/C Systems\*\***  
AHRI certificate included  
\*\* If not labeled Energy Star®, minimum SEER ≥14.5 for **split** systems and minimum SEER≥14 for single **package** equipment including gas/electric package units.
- **ENERGY STAR® Gas Boilers and Furnaces**
- **ENERGY STAR® Water Heaters**
- **ENERGY STAR® Programmable Thermostats**
- **ENERGY STAR® Closed-Loop Geothermal Heat Pumps\*\*\***  
AHRI certificate included  
\*\*\* If not labeled Energy Star®: **water to air** system must meet: EER 16.1/COP 3.5; **water to water** systems must meet EER 15.1/COP 3.0; and **DGX** systems must meet EER 16.0/COP 3.6.
- **Lighting**  
Replacement of non-IC-rated recessed “can” lights with ENERGY STAR® rated units that are installed and insulated to manufacturer specifications

### Variances

KHP projects will be eligible for program incentives if at least 85 percent of work performed is in the categories listed here. Improvements in the remaining 15 percent may include (all must be approved by KHP):

- Items related to or precursors of energy-efficiency improvements, such as electrical work that needs to be brought into compliance in order to install an HVAC system.
- Items related to indoor air quality, such as humidification or de-humidification.
