INCENTIVES FOR HOMEOWNERS

- Homeowners may be eligible for a \$150 rebate towards a whole-house energy evaluation for the first 1,000 homes participating in KY Home Performance (KHP), plus a free quality assurance (QA) evaluation. Evaluations must be performed by a participating KHP Building Performance Institute (BPI)-certified Building Analyst. Evaluations after the installation will be provided by a third-party independent QA provider.
- Homeowners may be eligible for a 20% rebate up to \$2,000 towards the installation of approved energy-efficient measures made to single-family residences participating in KHP.
- Homeowners are eligible to apply for a below-market unsecured loan in lieu of rebates for the installation of approved energy-efficient measures made to single-family residences participating in KHP. For homeowners who may not have the up-front funds for energy-efficient measures, for a limited time KHP can buy down the interest rate to a special 3.99 percent 10-year term up to \$20,000. Loan terms cannot exceed ten years of the life of the energy-efficiency equipment installed. Minimum credit score of 640, terms and other conditions apply.
- Homeowners may also qualify for additional rebates for qualifying improvements from participating utility providers as well as available state and federal tax credits.
